

Safe Medications for Pregnancy

Talk to your women's health provider for more information on safe medication before and during pregnancy. We cannot guarantee any medication is safe during pregnancy. This list is not intended to be all inclusive.

Condition/Symptom	Medicine
Allergy	 Allegra® (fexofenadine) – avoid antihistamines with "D" at the end. (e.g., Allergra-D) Benadryl® (diphenhydramine) 25 or 50 mg Zyrtec® (cetirizine) 10 mg once a day
Congestion	 Benadryl® (diphenhydramie) or Chlor-Trimeton® (chlorpheniramine) Sudafed® (pseudoephedrine) - may be used after the first 12 weeks of pregnancy. Should not be taken if patient has high blood pressure Vicks vapor rub or nasal spray Saline nasal spray Claritin® (loratadine) Zyrtec® (cetirzine) 10 mg once a day Neti pot or nasal irrigation
Constipation	 High fiber diet, increase fluids Metamucil® (psyllium) Citrucel® (methylcellulose) Milk of Magnesia® (magnesium hydroxide) FiberCon® (calcium polycarbophil) Colace® (docusate sodium) Senokot® (senna) Probiotics Magnesium 320 - 360 mg daily
Cough (alcohol free syrup)	 Cough drops or lozenges Robitussin DM® (dexlromethorphan, guaifenesin) may be used after the first 12 weeks of pregnancy Mucinex® (guaifenesin) may be used after the first 12 weeks of pregnancy
Diarrhea	• ImodiUM A-D® (Ioperamide)
Fever	Tylenol® (acetaminophen) products without aspirin

Gas	• Maalox® • Simethicone • Mylanta®
Heartburn	 Tums® (calcium carbonate) Rolaids® Mylanta® Maalox® Riopan® Pepcid® (famotidine) Probiotics
Hemorrhoids	 Anusol HC® (hydrocortisone) suppositories or cream Preparation H® (phenylephrine, pramoxine, glyserin, petrolatum) suppositories, cream or ointment Tucks® (witch hazel)
Nausea/Vomiting/ Motion Sickness	 Sea-bands® Vitamin B6 25 mg 3 times a day or 50 mg 2 times a day for a 4 - 5 day trial, continue if it helps, combine with doxylamine (unisom) 25 mg at bedtime Tums® Rolaids® Ginger/ginger tea Hard candy Aromatherapy: Lavender, ginger, peppermint or spearmint
Pain (headache or body ache) – call clinic if located in abdomen	 Tylenol® acetaminophen 650 mg every 6 hours or 1000 mg every 8 hours Heating pad
Sleep aid (may be taken at bedtime)	 Tylenol PM® (acetaminophen and diphenhydramine) Benadryl® (diphenhydramine) 25 mg or 50 mg Unisom® (doxylamine) 25 mg
Sore Throat	• Throat lozenges • Tylenol® (acetaminophen) • Saline gargles
Topicals (for itching/irritation)	 Hydrocortisone 0.5% or 1% (cream or ointment) Benadryl® (diphenhydramine) chewables, tablets, liquid or cream
Vitamins	Over-the-counter prenatal vitamins with 800 mcg folic acid
Yeast infection	 Clotrimazole (Gyne-lotrimin, Femcare, Mycelex) Monistat® (miconazole)
